WRITING RULES AND SUBMISSION Of PAPER ABSTRACTS AND SUBMISSION

Please submit your abstracts by email to sempozyum@gab.org.tr until December 11, 2021.

1. Abstract texts both Turkish and English to be sent to the Congress should be between 200-300 words, at least 3 keywords should be added to the end of the abstracts and up to 6 keywords should be added.
2. The title of the abstract text should be written in medium, bold and all letters should be uppercase (10 points).
3. The name of the author(s) should be written under the title; the academic title of the researcher, the institution where he/she works and the e-mail address should be written under each name.
4. Abstracts should be written using the Word template by the Times New Roman font. The font size should be 10 and there should be 1 cm spacing between the lines. The margins are "normal" (It should be set to right-left-2.5 cm from the top and bottom).
5. Abstracts should include the aim, methods, findings, results, and recommendations of the study. Shapes or tables are not allowed in the abstract text. The summary should not contain citations.
6. All submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the referee in terms of format and relevance to the topic of the congress. The Organizing Committee will make the final decision on the adoption of the declaration.
7. The papers must not have been submitted or sent for publication elsewhere before.
